

RECEIVE TUITION CREDIT AND HELP SCS!!

There are two things you can do to help lower your tuition:

1. **NEW FAMILY REFERRAL PROGRAM (for families who have been with Salisbury Christian School for one school year or longer)** – If you refer a new family to SCS and that family is accepted and begins making their monthly payments, you will receive a credit to your family's tuition account for the school year the new children begin attending. There is a place on the new family application for the applicant to put your name as a referral. Your family's discount amount will be \$150 per new child. For example, if a new family has mentioned you as the referral family for them and the new family have two children who attend SCS, your family will receive a credit of \$300 towards tuition. The credits are issued in October; you will be notified by the business office that a credit has been applied to your account. If the new family mentions several families as referrals, the referral credit will be split evenly between those families.
2. **SCRIP PROGRAM** – Order scrip cards from our business office to purchase groceries, gas, clothes, etc. (just about everything) through participating stores. Stores on the list have agreed to give a rebate back to the school in percentages up to 25% when purchases are made through the scrip cards. SCS will share half the rebate with the family who purchased the cards. For example, the rebate percentage for Barnes & Noble is 9%. If you purchase scrip cards for Barnes & Noble totaling \$100, SCS will get a rebate of \$9. SCS will keep \$4.50; the other \$4.50 will go toward your tuition account. Some scrip cards are kept on hand in the business office (Wal Mart, Food Lion, Lowes, Panera, Exxon, Regal Cinema and quite a few more). You may simply come in and purchase them. Many more cards are available by ordering them through the business office. The cards will be ordered at 12:00 p.m. on the 15th and 30th of each month (or the next business day if the 15th or 30th fall on a weekend). Several times per year (Thanksgiving, Christmas and Spring break time), the cards may be ordered earlier than the dates just mentioned due to the business office being closed; be sure to check on the order date if you want to order cards around those times. The cards will be available for pick-up three to four business days after they are ordered. The business office will call you when they come in. They are used like a gift card; use it until it's gone. Further information about this program as well as the order form is available on the SCS web site.
