Payment Policy for Summer Camp Tuition

Payment must be made for each week (or portion of a week) that your child is registered for camp. Payment is expected **NO LATER THAN THE FIRST DAY** of each week that your child attends. Payments should be placed in a sealed envelope, labeled with your child's name and given to either the business office or Camp Registrar in the Lower School office.

Be advised that you are responsible for payment for all sessions for which your child is registered. If you find the need to cancel, you must give one week notice. No refund will be made because of withdrawal or absence with less than one week notice. **CANCELLATIONS MADE LESS THAN ONE WEEK IN ADVANCE STILL REQUIRE PAYMENT.**
