RE: Sussex Bus Route

Salisbury Christian School will again offer a bus route to and from the Sussex County area for the 2010-2011 school year. Please read the following information carefully as you make plans for the next school year.

What do I need to do to secure a seat for my child on the bus?

Fill out a SCS Bus Registration form and attach the \$50 registration fee. It can be returned to the main office. This service will be provided on a "first come- first served" basis. There will only be 50 open seats on the bus, so return your registration form as soon as possible. You will receive a "Confirmation" (of service provided or denied) within a few weeks of registering.

What will it cost me?

- Registration Fee: \$50 per family per year (non-refundable). The registration stays in effect for the entire school year unless you contact the business manager.
- Round Trip Rates (billed June-May...just like tuition)
 - 1 rider \$480 per year...equates to \$40.00 per month
 - 2 riders \$760 per year...equates to \$63.00 per month
 - 3 or more riders \$950 per year...equates to \$79.00 per month

Note: There is a 2% discount available to families that pay the full annual bus fee as their first payment.

- One Way Fares: ½ price.
- Monthly Payment Due: Bus fees are due the 1st day of each month along with your tuition payment. Late fees apply.
- Non-registered bus students riding the bus with a regular rider shall fill out a "Special Daily Rider" form and pay a \$5.00 fee (24 hour notice required).
- FYI: In light of unstable fuel prices, SCS reserves the right to adjust bus fees if necessary.

Where will the bus stops be on the route?

Riders and parents will be required to sign a "Bus Safety Guidelines" sheet before being allowed to ride the bus.

- Pick up at Millsboro Rt. 20 at Uncle Willie's, drop off at Workman's Store
- Seaford at Royal Farms
- Pick up at Laurel at Discount Land, drop off at Laurel at Bargain Bill's Flea Market
