Salisbury Christian School is a coeducational, college preparatory school for grades pre-kindergarten (age three) through twelve. Now in its 53rd year, SCS has grown from a small preschool to a prominent school with a current enrollment of 545 students. The three-building campus is home to the Madeline Godfrey Perdue gymnasium, two fully-equipped science labs, an upper school media center and library, a lower school library, two technology labs, and athletic fields for soccer, baseball, and softball. With 50 faculty and 11 instructional assistants, the average class size is 19. The faculty tenure average is 11 years.

Located on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, Salisbury is the county seat of Wicomico County, population 102,000. A growing, mostly rural community, Salisbury is the home of the Perdue Corporation Headquarters, a thriving medical center, and the distinguished Salisbury University. Atlantic Ocean beaches and resorts are a short distance away.

PERFORMING and VISUAL ARTS



SCS has award-winning band and choral programs for grades 4 to 12. Lower school students participate in two annual on-site musical productions and various community performances. Upper school students perform in local and national band and choral competitions as well as on-site programs. The drama department annually produces a fall drama and a spring musical; recent productions include *The Little Mermaid*, *Our Town*, and *Fiddler on the Roof*. Productions planned for 2019-20 are *Miracle on 34th Street* and *Little Women*. Visual arts students have their artwork displayed in several on-campus and off-campus art shows and competitions.

SPIRITUAL DEVELOPMENT

Salisbury Christian School provides opportunities for spiritual growth at every grade level. Subjects are taught from a Christian perspective and Bible classes are part of the curriculum for all grades. Students participate in regular Spiritual Emphasis Days and a weekly chapel service with their age group. Chapel includes student-led worship. The senior class participates in a one-week international mission trip each year.
