Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Who can take a Summer Scholars class?

A: Students who have completed 8th grade and are re-enrolled for the next school year.

Q: How will a summer course be beneficial?

A: Students will create more flexibility in their school year schedule by freeing up a class period. They can make room for additional AP courses, electives, study halls, etc.

Q: Can I still take more P.E. classes during the year if I take the summer class?

A: Of course! You can still take P.E. classes, but the minimum requirement of 1/2 credit will be met in the two-week class.

Q: Is there a dress code for summer?

A: Yes, but the theme is casual and modest. No short-shorts, but modest t-shirts are permitted.

Due to the brief nature of this program, a full-letter grade reduction is given for one absence. In the event that a student misses more than one class for any reason, he or she will be dropped from the class. Refunds are not issued.
